# CARNIVAL

## 13 NOVEMBER 2010

Our inaugural carnival is almost upon us and I am absolutely thrilled at the enthusiasm and energy which has enveloped the school around this project. Thank-you to all who have given so much time and energy already into this project.

There have been many questions surrounding the carnival so here is a list of Frequently Asked Questions :

**1) Who is co-ordinating this event?**

The carnival is co-ordinated by a task team consisting of teachers and parents. Each class ambassador is responsible for ensuring that their class runs an event/stall and that this is properly planned and executed on the day.

**2) Who is going to run each stall on the day of the carnival?**

Every parent will have to give some time to be on duty at their class stall on the day. The class ambassadors will set up a roster. Should you have a child in more than one class you are asked to give at least one hour to each class. For this event to be successful each parent will have to give of their time and effort.

**3) What attractions will there be for my family and friends?**

Bubble Balls in which you can float on water, tea garden, beer tent, wine tasting, karaoke, face painting, old-fashioned carnival games, merry-go-round for the little ones, target shooting, karaoke and the dropping of a bag of flour on a target from an aeroplane are some of the attractions.

Several food stalls will also be in operation on the day ranging from slap chips to Brazilian hotdogs to boerewors rolls to steak burgers to tea savouries and sweets.

#### 4) What is being done to market the event?

Large banners are being painted and will be erected on Church Square, on the fences of a few local schools and on the fence facing Heyn Street on Roux Road. Both KFM and Vallei FM have been contacted and are marketing the event. We are printing flyers to be distributed around Worcester in the coming days and will have several large posters at well-frequented places around town and in Robertson, De Doorns and Wolseley.

In the days leading up to the Carnival Weekend colourful bands will be tied around the trees in Distillery Road and the top end of Church Street while bright arrows will point towards the school.

Several parents will be visiting homes in the surrounding suburbs early evening on the 4<sup>th</sup> of November to market the carnival. Grade 6, 7 and 8 pupils are welcome to join them provided they are in full school uniform and accompanied by their parent/s. Any parents wishing to be part of this campaign, please arrive at school at **18h00** where you will be met and given further instructions.

Most importantly, you will be given 10 invites which you are asked to give to friends, family and colleagues. Your personal invitation will carry far more weight than any external advertising we employ so please get out there and invite people! Feel free to take the A4 advert attached to this newsletter and distribute as you see fit!

Our inaugural carnival promises to be a wonderful event. It will need every member of our school community to be involved if it is to reach its potential – I look forward to working with you in making this a truly fantastic experience for all.
