



SCHOOL UNIFORM – High School

Shirt :

- Summer – Open collar white school shirt with school badge sewn on pocket (ordered from De Jagers)
- Winter – Plain white long-sleeved school shirt with button-up collar

Pants :

- Boys
 - Summer : Khaki shorts from De Jagers
 - Winter : Khaki long pants from De Jagers with a brown or black belt

Skirts :

- Girls
 - Summer and Winter : Wrap around skirt in the Lanner House plaid fabric (available from De Jagers)
 - No shorts or skorts may be worn
 - Winter : Thick cream stockings may be worn for warmth

Pullover :

- Plain navy pullover with school badge sewn on the pocket
- Both boys and girls may wear the Lanner House pullover jersey

Blazer :

- Dark navy blue blazer with silver buttons with school badge sewn on pocket (available from De Jagers)
- Ownership of a blazer is compulsory. They may be worn to school but are not obligatory. They must be worn at formal school functions and on outings off-campus.

Tie :

- Plain navy school tie with embroidered school logo(available from De Jagers)

Shoes :

- Brown shoes to be worn by boys and girls
- Girls : White socks; Boys : Brown socks (no ankle or 'secret' socks allowed)

Sporting clothes :

- Navy shorts, white t-shirt, Lanner House hockey socks and white sport shoes (no more than 25% of shoe to be either blue or green)

Please note the following :

- Shirts are to tucked in at all times. Sleeves of long-sleeve white shirts may be rolled up neatly.
- During the winter ties are worn at all times. The top button of the shirt must be fastened and the tie pulled up.
- Shoes must be clean at all times.
- No jerseys or t-shirts may be worn underneath the official school shirt or jersey.
- Girls may not wear eye-liner or lip-gloss or thick mascara to school. Clear nail polish is allowed.
- Students may not wear jewellery with their uniform except for a small gold or silver cross on a thin long chain. Girls may wear plain studs or sleepers (one in the bottom of each ear). No pearl or diamond earrings.
- Girls may wear a white, green or navy scrunchie or aliceband in their hair. Navy combs and silver or dark clips may be worn.
- Long socks, worn for sport, must be pulled up at all times.
- Girls should wear their skirts at a length considered to be appropriate.
- On occasion when students are permitted to come to school in civvies they should at all times be appropriately dressed.
- Boys' hair should be appropriately short and neatly styled. Girls' hair should be tied back neatly and be out of the eyes.
- No student may colour his or her hair in any colour other than natural colours. Only one natural colour is permitted.
- Boys must be clean shaven.
- Students may wear smart-casual clothes when they attend matches or concerts as spectators unless formal school uniform has been prescribed.
- Jerseys may not be worn around the waist.
- Sport uniform items may not be worn with the school uniform.
- Students are required to ensure that their appearance and attire are, on all occasions, presentable and appropriate so as to bring credit to them as students, their families and Lanner House High School.
